Call for 2012 Proposals

Officially established on July 1, 2009, the Committee for Promotion of Ming-Qing Studies is responsible for promoting and coordinating research in Ming-Qing studies in Academia Sinica. The Committee consists of both ex-officio and elected members, nine in total, who serve a two-year term. Dr. Chung Tsai-chun 鍾彩鈞 is the current director of the Committee, who will be succeeded by Dr. Hsieh Kuo-hsing 謝國興 in January 2012. Funding of the Committee is authorized by the Vice President of Academia Sinica, and the budget is reviewed and approved annually. To plan for the activities in 2012, the Committee now invites proposals for **study groups and workshops in relation to Ming-Qing studies** from colleagues. The application process is as follows:

1. We support study groups, workshops (typically one to two days events), and other activities of similar nature;
2. Acceptance of proposals is at the discretion of the Committee and will be based on relevance and quality;
3. The Committee is considering proposals by individuals or groups (all colleagues from the rank of Assistant Research Fellow or above can apply);
4. Please submit proposals which include: 1) a statement of purpose; 2) participants; nature and plans for activities; 3) detailed budget requirements, etc.
5. The application deadline is Sunday, November 20, 2011;
